## GUIDELINES FOR USE OF DIARY

### For Parents:-

Parents must go through the instruction given in the diary carefully.

### For Students:-

- ✦ Keep the diary neat and clean.
- ✦ Bring the diary regularly to school.
- ✦ Note the home-work and other school activities in the diary every day.
- ✦ Show the diary to your parents and bring back replies to the teacher's note/ remarks.
- ✦ Fix hours for home study in consultation with parents. While preparing for study at home, the homework instructions given by the teacher must be read and acted upon. This habit pays in the long run.

### NOTE TO PARENT/GUARDIAN:

- ✦ A strict disciplinary action will be taken against any defaulter.
- ✦ Kindly do not send money with the student unless instructed by the school.
- ✦ He/she must not use abusive language and disrespectful expressions for others.
- ✦ Keeping unauthorized reading material is strictly prohibited in the school campus.
- ✦ Persons carrying arms shall not be allowed to enter the school premises in any case.
- ✦ The school shall not be responsible for any injury received by the student while undertaking any academic or extracurricular activities in or out of the school e.g. practical exams, sports, trips, tours, horse riding and swimming, etc.
- ✦ The school rules can be modified at any point during an academic session without any prior notice and these modified rules will be applicable to all old and new students.
- ✦ Aptitude capabilities and interest do vary from person to person. Hence, a child's academic performance should never be compared with that of others. However, the school puts in its sincerest efforts for an all-round development of each student.

- ✦ Students should be neatly dressed. The school uniform is to be worn on every working day. Students who are not neatly dressed or are not in uniform will be strictly dealt with. He/she must comply with instructions, regarding proper and standard haircut and school uniform.
- ✦ Girls should plait their hair if it is below the shoulders. Short hair should be neatly cut and pinned. Only maroon ribbons and hair bands are permitted.
- ✦ Students are not to wear any jewellery in the school (no chains, rings, bangles, and bracelets). Girls may wear only one pair of small ear studs.
- ✦ He/she must not scribble on the walls/doors of the school building, corridors, toilets etc. No graffiti is allowed on the school walls. Student found guilty of damaging school property will be asked to bear the cost of repair or replacement of the damage.
- ✦ Every student is required to arrive to school on time. He/she will not be permitted after three late arrivals in a month, and a written explanation will be sought for.
- ✦ He/she must not break school property / furniture, green boards, window panes, smart boards etc. In case found guilty, strict disciplinary action will be taken apart from having made to compensate the loss.
- ✦ Students against whom disciplinary action may have been taken or whose presence in school may prove to be detrimental to the general discipline of the school will not be allowed to join school.
- ✦ He/she is not allowed to bring crackers, holi colours, walkman, I-pods, cell phones, cameras, transistors etc. to the school. The school is not accountable for loss of any expensive item brought by the child in the school.
- ✦ In the school bus, all the students must follow instructions of the T.O.D. failing which he/she will not be allowed to avail the bus facility. No one, apart from the student availing the bus service will be allowed to board the bus. Disciplinary action may result in issuing of a memo: Negative reflection in the student's conduct report. Third memo could lead to rustication.



### RECOMMENDATION TO GUARDIANS

- ✦ Children, when sick must not be sent to school to attend classes.
- ✦ Parents must refrain from giving gifts to teachers on any occasion.
- ✦ Parents are requested to inform the school office if there is any change in the address/contact no's.
- ✦ Parents are requested not to enter the classrooms either to see their children or to seek interviews with teachers during school hours.
- ✦ Leave for half a day should be avoided as far as possible for security reasons. In an emergency, written permission must be taken from the principal and the class teacher.
- ✦ It is always advisable to write to the school about the problems of your ward or for seeking guidance. Whenever you write to the school about your ward, always quote his/her full name, class, section and admission number.
- ✦ You are requested to co-operate with the school in its attempt to help your child's progress by paying attention to his/her work. Parents should check the diary everyday and note the homework and any other instruction given and acknowledge the same by signing in the space meant for the same. Parents are advised to check the bags of their wards to see if any notice, invitation etc. has been issued.
- ✦ Parent's attention is drawn to the fact that criticism of a teacher or the school in the presence of the child causes the child to lose his/her respect for the teacher and only hinders his/her progress.
- ✦ Any communication made by the parents should be addressed to Principal and not to the class teacher and all correspondence from the parent to the school must go through Principal.
- ✦ Students should get their report cards signed by their parents/guardians within three days of the receipt of the Report Card and return them to the class teachers. If the card is lost, a fine of Rs. 50/- will be imposed.
- ✦ Parents are requested to co-operate in the working of the school by enforcing regularity and discipline and ensuring that the school rules are observed by the child.
- ✦ Parents are strictly advised to celebrate their child's birthday in a modest manner. Only two toffees should be distributed among the classmates of the child. Distribution of the lavish sweet packets or gift hampers will not be entertained on any occasion in the school.

## **RULES REGARDING**

### **A.Fee**

- 1.Fee is charged for all the 12 months of the session. Any fee once deposited in the school is non-transferable/non-refundable.
- 2.All Fee is to be paid in advance for the quarter and on or before the 10<sup>th</sup> of the first month of the quarter i.e.
  - I Quarter-April to June (by the 10<sup>th</sup> of April)
  - II Quarter-July to Sept. (by the 10<sup>th</sup> of July)
  - III Quarter-Oct. to Dec. (by the 10<sup>th</sup> of Oct.)
  - IV Quarter-Jan. to March (by the 10<sup>th</sup> of Jan.)
- 3.In case of non-payment of fee:
  - I.A fine of Rs. 50/- will be charged as late payment fine up to the 20<sup>th</sup> of the first month of the quarter.
  - II.A flat sum to Rs.100/- will be charged after the 20<sup>th</sup> of the first month of the quarter.
  - III.City Public School, Tapukara holds the right to strike off the name of the student from the roll on non-payment of the fee after the first month of the quarter. In such a case the school management reserves the right to re-admission.
- 4.The fee receipt is to be maintained by the parent for at least one academic session.
- 5.In case of any dispute/discrepancy regarding deposition of fee, the decision of the school management will be final and binding on the parent/guardian.
- 6.The school considers the payment of the total fee at the time of admission.  
In such a case the payee shall get a concession of 10% on the tuition fee.

### **B.WITHDRAWALS**

- ✦ One clear calendar month notice in writing before the payment of the next quarterly fee or complete quarterly fee in lieu of such a notice must be given before a pupil can be withdrawn.
- ✦ Transfer certificate will be issued only after all dues of the school are settled.
- ✦ Security if not settled within three months of withdrawal will be forfeited.
- ✦ The school authorities may ask, without prior notice to the parent to withdraw the child from the school on the following grounds:
  - Academics: unsatisfactory progress in work or failure in the same class for two consecutive sessions
  - Irregularity in attendance
  - Indiscipline.

### **C.ABSENCE**

- ✦ It is compulsory for students to maintain 80% attendance in the current academic session in order to be eligible to take the final exams except on medical grounds.
- ✦ A child who has been absent on the previous day/days will be allowed to the class only on production of a leave application duly signed by the parent stating reason for the same.
- ✦ Leave on medical grounds will be entertained on production of a medical certificate by an authorized physician.
- ✦ Leave for going out of station should be sanctioned by the school authorities, prior to proceeding on leave.
- ✦ Students absenting themselves on tests or exams without prior sanction will be awarded a zero in that test or exam.
- ✦ All students are expected to attend the school on the opening day after each vacation. Those absent without sanctioned leave will be fined Rs. 50/- per day.
- ✦ In case a student stops attending the school without any prior information to the school authority his /her name will be struck off from school roll after six consecutive days of absence and re-admission will be granted only after seeking a written permission from Principal and depositing the re-admission fee.

### **D.NORMS FOR PROMOTION**

- A minimum of 80% attendance is required during the session.
- Promotion will be granted to the student on the basis of his/her overall performance during the academic session through the continuous and comprehensive evaluation.

### **SCHOOL TRANSPORT**

Students can avail the school transport, subject to availability of seats. The school does not entertain any request for change in bus route to suit an individual's convenience. As a rule, such request should not be made. In case of emergency, parents should take their wards personally with prior permission of the principal.

#### **Parents to please note bus rules**

- 1.No student will board the bus without an identity card.
- 2.Unauthorized persons are not allowed to travel by the school bus.
- 3.The buses will pick up students from and drop them at their respective stops as per the school schedule.
- 4.It is the responsibility of the parents to escort their wards into the bus in the morning and from the bus stop in the afternoon.
- 5.Bus commuters and escorts are expected to reach their respective stops 10 min. before the scheduled time.
- 6.Discipline at the stop and inside the bus should be maintained. Students will be held responsible for any damage to buses caused by negligence or vandalism.
- 7.Bus charges will be charged for all the twelve months of the session and should be paid in advance along with the school fee.
- 8.If a student wants to discontinue the bus facility during the session, he will have to pay one month extra charge or give one month notice.
- 9.Parents are requested to refrain from breaking into any argument with staff on board. Any grievances regarding bus services or the staff on board should be made in the school office to the transport in charge/Principal. On no account should any parent delay the school bus.
- 10.The bus facility is extended as a privilege and cannot be claimed as a right. It can be withdrawn any time due to any emergency.
- 11.Parents are expected to cooperate with the school authorities in case of delay of bus arrival at the stop. During morning hours a bus commuter is expected to wait at the stop for at least 20 min. for the bus before returning home.

**NOTE: Students are not allowed to come to school on self-driven scooters/motorcycles without license and helmet.**

### HOUSE SYSTEM

The house system forms the basis of all competitions in the school. It promotes in the child qualities such as team spirit, loyalty, commandership, sacrifice and healthy competition. The entire school has been divided into four houses, namely Aryabhatta, Dr. Kalam, Panini and Charaka. Such divisions are intended to cultivate and awaken in the child a spirit for excellence as part of his/her group and to learn to lose with honor and to be magnanimous in victory. Each house is supervised by house mistress/house master for various affairs, who in turn is assisted by a team of teachers and students for managing day to day commitments. Students compete in the inter house competitions demonstrating their talents and skills to bring glory to their respective houses.
