Building: the State-of-the Art Design

The school building has been scientifically designed maintaining modernity and the apt educational environs for scholastic and co-scholastic arena. Climate has a major effect on building's performance and energy consumption. Architectural design of the building is adapted in such a way, that it shields the indoor environment from the external climate and acts as a **Climate Modifier**. Solar radiation is the most important factor affecting human thermal comfort. The school building/class rooms' orientation is based upon cardinal directions, also vertical louvers have been designed in such a way that it maximizes the amount of sun rays which heats the space in winter and decreases the amount of sun rays that makes the classrooms cooler in summer. This will give the best thermal comfort and natural environment to the students throughout the year. In fact, this environmental feature is considered better than air conditioned buildings because air conditioned buildings reduce body's resistance. In addition, it reduces the amount of energy required to heat or cool the building, hence reducing the running cost and makes it a **Green Building**.

Smart Class & Classrooms

Spacious and well ventilated classrooms keep the drudgery of the sweltering summer heat away from the children. The web support facilitated classrooms does away with the monotony of the traditional classroom teaching and multiplies the teaching learning capacity of the teacher and the taught.



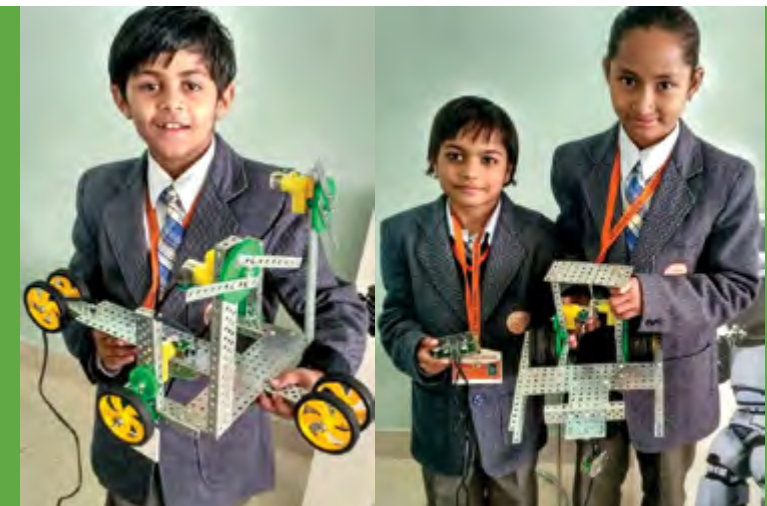
The Furniture

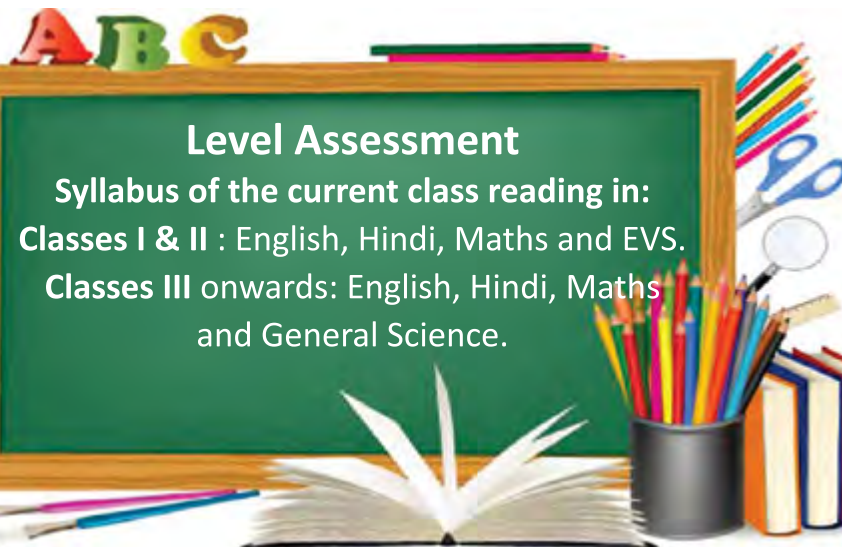

Admission Procedure



Age criteria for Admission



Pre-nursery : The child should be 3+ on 01 April of the corresponding year.

Kindergarten : The child should be 4+ on 01 April of the corresponding year.

Preparatory : The child should be 5+ on 01 April of the corresponding year.

Class - I : The child should be 6+ on 01 April of the corresponding year.
(The same criteria continue for the rest of the higher classes)

1. Filling up of the registration form (registration does not guarantee admission)
2. Taking the LEVEL ASSESSMENT as per the date given by the school on the school premises.
3. On selection, within a week of intimation, fulfilling all the admission formalities which includes filling up of all the forms provided by the school, furnishing all the required documents to the school office along with deposition of the fee. Fee once deposited will not be refunded.
Admission to Nursery, Kindergarten, and Preparatory will be purely on first come first serve basis.
4. Both parent should be present at the time of interview/interaction.



Documents required at the time of admission

1. Original Birth Certificate.
2. Original TC (if applicable).
3. Character Certificate.
4. Proof of Category (if applicable).
5. Last School Report Card.
6. Certificate of disability (if applicable).
7. Photostat Copy of Immunization Card.
8. 6 passport size recent colour photographs of the student.
9. 6 passport size recent colour photographs of mother, father and guardian.
10. Medical fitness certificate (height, weight, blood group & eye sight).

Curriculum



Primary (I to V)

The Academic programme will comprise the subjects- English, Hindi, Mathematics, E.V.S. (classes I & II), General Science, Social Studies, Computer, General Knowledge, Value Education and Physical Education. The methodology will incorporate the nine multiple approaches, besides gathering first hand information through educational trips and visits of professional from concerned fields.

Pre-Primary

The pedagogy in this wing is a blend of Montessori Method, Activity based Learning supported by Audio Visual aids. The pace of learning is child-paced. The key focus is on personality development - inter and intra personal skills, emotional stability besides cognitive development and a transition from gross motor skills to fine motor skills. The curriculum includes curricular and co-curricular activities mainly English, Hindi, Basic Mathematics, Art and Craft, Singing, Dancing, Dramatics, Games, Gymnastics, Yoga and Oratory Skills.

Middle School Onwards

The Academic programme will comprise the subjects- English, Hindi, Sanskrit/ French/Japanese(as per the child's preference), Mathematics, Integrated Science, Social Science (History, Civics, Geography and Disaster Management), Computer, General Knowledge, Value Education & Physical Education. Focus will be on Project based learning, Group Discussion and Hands on Learning, besides incorporation of the nine multiple approaches, gathering first hand information through educational trips and visits of professional from concerned fields.

NORMS FOR PROMOTION

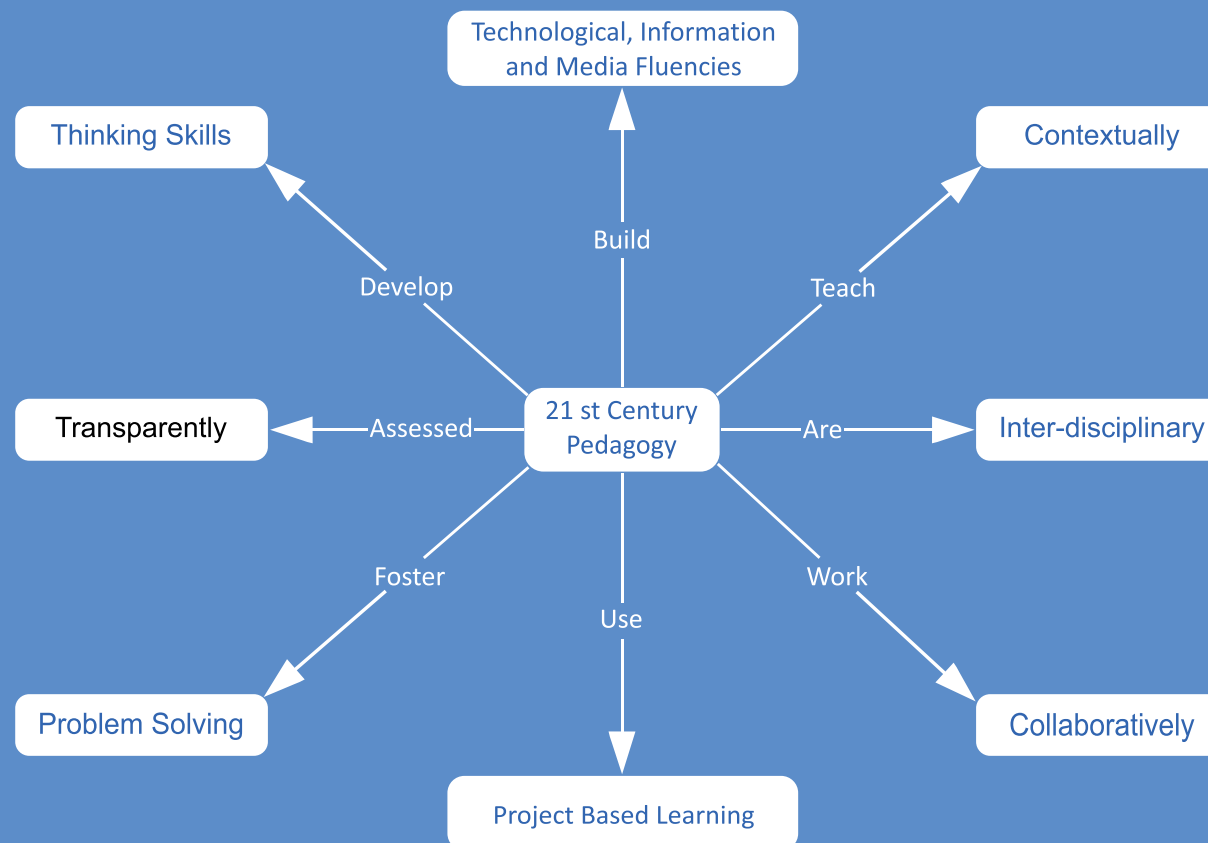

What, How, Why We Learn

The school follows the CBSE Curriculum. The teaching methodology and technology is kept abreast with the latest trends in child pedagogy. The curriculum is well-blend to balance the curricular and the co-curricular activities.

The entire Academic zone is web enabled and all the classes are smart. The scholars are motivated to explore, and learn by observation as all learning comes from nature. Learning by Doing and Activity based learning is earnestly given the impetus in the classrooms. All learning is child centred. Personality development is the hallmark of our education. The student teacher ratio is 10:1 and the class strength is maintained between 35 and 40.

Rules Regarding

Fee

1. Fee is charged for all the 12 months of the session. Any fee ones deposited in the school is non-transferable/non-refundable.
2. All Fee is to be paid in advance for the quarter and on or before the 10th of the first month of the quarter i.e.
 - I Quarter - April to June (by the 10th of April)
 - II Quarter - July to Sept. (by the 10th of July)
 - III Quarter - Oct. to Dec. (by the 10th of Oct.)
 - IV Quarter - Jan. to March (by the 10th of Jan.)
3. In case of non-payment of fee:
 - i. A fine of ₹ 50/- will be charged as late payment fine up to the 20th of the first month of the quarter.
 - ii. A flat sum to ₹ 100/- will be charged after the 20th of the first month of the quarter.
 - iii. City Public School, Bhiwadi holds the right to strike off the name of the student from the roll on non-payment of the fee after the first month of the quarter. In such a case the school management reserves the right to re-admission.
4. The fee receipt is to be maintained by the parent for at least one academic session.
5. In case of any dispute/discrepancy regarding deposition of fee, the decision of the school management will be final and binding on the parent/guardian.
